## French chefs bring seasonal treats for discerning diners

Having made his first trip to Hong Kong as a guest chef in 2008, Alban Rousseau is returning - this time with his business partner, Charlie Lesellier.

From September 8 to 15, the French duo will be offering diners at H One in the IFC mall a special menu designed using seasonal French products and prepared with their modern cooking techniques.

The menu includes roasted sea bass Breton with peach and candied carrots, egg mollet goat cheese, croutons and herb vinaigrette, and tiger prawns, brandada, radish, chives and white wine cream foam, among other dishes.

Educated at La Rochelle Hotel School, Rousseau has a number of inspirational figures to thank for his cooking style.

He has worked in various Michelin-starred restaurants and has learned from celebrity chefs including Daniel Boulud, Philippe Legendre and Alain Ducasse.

He is now owner of gastronomy consultant RousseauLesellier, which advises restaurants, hotels and caterers on cooking authentic French cuisine.
